This person will work with the cleanroom assembly, Procurement / Supply Chain for the facility to ensure final product shipped meets all relevant Quality standards and responsible for the Training programme for all staff including cleanroom operators.

- Responsible for Audits (Suppliers & regulatory ISO) including planning, coordination, compliance & reporting / documentation. Liaise with Sales and Purchasing / Supply chain on same.
- Develop and maintain change notification programme.
- Responsible for RMA & CAPA procedures and operation of same.
- Report on the performance of the management system to leadership.
- Champion and lead continuous improvement of the quality management system.
- Lead process improvement initiatives using a systematic approach.
- Communicate regularly with customers, suppliers, and internal team members.
- Attending educational workshops and reviewing professional publications.
- Benchmarking quality activities & keeping up to speed with relevant standards such as ISO /GMP.
- Participate in customer and supplier visits with the sales team to facilitate auditing & evaluation as appropriate.
- NDA Policies, T & C's, Supply and Quality Agreements.
- Meet deadlines and work towards set team and departmental targets.
- Other duties as deemed necessary by company management to support this role.
