Reporting to the Operations Manager, this position will be based in our Cork Headquarters located in North Esk Industrial Estate, Dunkettle, Co. Cork.

This is a permanent role incorporating responsibilities for the handling of Inventory, Picking, Packing, & Shipping product to support our business portfolio.

Duties of the Role include:

- Receive, inspect, and process all goods inwards and goods outwards activities, ensuring accuracy and compliance with company procedures.
- Maintain effective inventory control, including stock checks, stock movements, and accurate record keeping within the stores function.
- Assist with stock reporting, cycle counts, and inventory audits as required.
- Operate company equipment, including Counterbalance and Reach Forklifts, in a safe and efficient manner.
- Work collaboratively with internal departments to ensure timely and accurate movement of materials and products.
- Support the continuous improvement of stores processes and inventory management practices.
- Maintain the cleanliness, organisation, and general upkeep of the stores area, equipment, and company assets.
- Ensure adherence to all Health & Safety policies, safe systems of work, and the correct use of personal protective equipment (PPE).
- Comply with company Quality Management Systems, including ISO 9001 standards, and all relevant Health & Safety procedures.
- Carry out any other duties reasonably required to support business operations and customer requirements.

- Current or previous Counterbalance and Reach Forklift certification and operating experience.
- Experience using warehouse/inventory management systems and general IT applications.
